
Gallipolis is a quaint, quiet village along the Ohio River rich in tradition, culture and people. We have had our struggles, like any small town, but have persevered through the tough times.

We have a fantastic regional hospital (over 120 physicians), a large agricultural community and several manufacturing industries. We have an active Chamber of Commerce, CIC (Community Improvement Corporation) and Downtown Digital River Project as well as several other civic and cultural organizations that work hard to keep Gallipolis and Gallia County moving forward.

However, as with most metropolitan areas, cities, towns and villages federal assistance is necessary to sustain the momentum. We have an extraordinary county engineer who has identified a project that will greatly affect our area that requires federal funding.

The project to finish the extension of Farm Road into Gallipolis would greatly alleviate flooding and traffic issues along current State Route 7 and provide a more direct route into downtown. This area has been subject to numerous floods, sometimes annually, that cause great difficulties to industry and local businesses.
