I am writing this letter to express my support for the Appalachian Ohio Infrastructure Gateway Project BUILD grant application submitted by the Gallia County Engineer's Office. The Appalachian Ohio Infrastructure Gateway Project will raise the quality of life for "at risk residents" and will improve transportation conditions for the local farmers and tourists in the region.

The Appalachian Ohio Infrastructure Gateway Project will replace 130 miles of stone and dirt county roads with a hard surface designed by Ohio University.
