On behalf of Connected Nation and Connect Ohio, I enthusiastically write today to provide my unconditional support, and respectfully request your attention to, the Southeast Ohio Innovative Smart Connection project application. The project consists of: 1) adding an interchange along US Route 35 while utilizing an existing overpass bridge and four rest-area ramps and 2) developing a State Route 7 bypass route along Bob Evans Highway/Farm Road to alleviate costly impacts to businesses and residents from flooding and congestion.
